Transfer of entire world-wide replacement parts distribution:

MWM implements inconsoWMS X

Near to its site in Mannheim, MWM GmbH, one of the world-wide leading system suppliers of high performance and environmentally friendly complete plants for decentral energy supply with gas and diesel motors, has set up a new distribution center for the

world-wide replacement parts supply. inconso AG was contracted to deliver the required solution. The logistics solution provided is inconsoWMS X.

The origins of MWM GmbH lie in the mechanical workshop founded by Carl Benz in 1871, later the Motorenwerke Mannheim AG. In 2007, MWM went out of the Deutz company as an independent company again. The supply of their customers, cooperation partners and subsidiaries with replacement parts is currently located in the early company. As of September 1, 2009, these tasks will be taken over from their own distribution center by a service provider.

inconsoWMS will guarantee a smooth transfer of the previous processes in the replacement parts supply center of Deutz AG, where it will be used as well, to the new setup of MWM GmbH. At the beginning of September 2009, the transfer of the over 40,000 active part numbers of the existing material spectrum from Cologne to Mannheim will begin. From the start, this tremendous task will be supported by inconsoWMS X. To ensure the delivery capability during the transfer period, the old and new warehouse sites will be managed by the leading supplier of consulting and software solutions for logistics in Germany.

Different from the current automated warehouse and conveyor technology used in Cologne, the processes in the new MWM warehouse will be mainly completed with RF support. The order consolidation will be realized via a dynamic buffer location management which are connected to differentiated pack locations and shipping processes. Especially important for MWM is the takeover of the highly complex interfaces to the SAP Host system which inconso has implemented to cover all the specific requirements of the world-wide replacement part distribution.
